

I really love these crossword puzzle books. The puzzles aren't what I'd call easy, but they're not frustratingly difficult, either. They're fun. Plus, they're spiral bound, the size is just right, the paper quality is good, and the photos on the covers put me in a good mood. To help you see where I'm coming from, I'm not the biggest fan of the New York Times puzzles....I find a lot of them too hard or too annoying. I like Merl Reagle's, Random House, and New York Magazine puzzles.

The spiral binding is excellent for folding out to do the puzzles. The paper has a good tooth but is smooth so pen or pencil work well and if you use pencil, erasing is easy. The answers at the back of the book have additional information to further educate you. All in all an excellent product.

For the most part it's good - i've only done about 15 of the puzzles - most of them take some thought but are doable - a few aren't so good - i'm probably not the smartest person out there, but as far as i'm concerned in a couple of them they get to cute (which i don't enjoy,) or contain clues the normal person wouldn't know about or you would have to belong to mensa to figure out - over all tho, i've enjoyed the ones i've done and the fact that they made me think -- if you like a fairly

challenging crossword book (at least by my standards,) this one is basically pretty good --- if you get it, i hope you enjoy it ---
